RE: Complaint Concerning Harmony Public Charter School Board's Compliance with the Open Meetings Act (#OOG-2026-0009)

Thank you for your continuing interest in government transparency. This correspondence concerns the complaint you submitted to the Board of Ethics and Government Accountability ("BEGA") Office of Open Government on April 29, 2026, which alleges violations by Harmony Public Charter School Board of the Open Meetings Act (D.C. Official Code § 2-571 *et seq.*). OOG reviewed the complaint, assigned it file number OOG-2026-0009, and a review of the matter was undertaken pursuant to 3 DCMR § 10400 *et seq.* For the reason set forth below, OOG must dismiss this matter.

After careful review, OOG has determined that the issues raised in your complaint have already been addressed. Specifically, the matters identified were resolved in connection with OOG's issuance of its advisory opinion dated April 8, 2026, in matter number OOG-2025-0023. In that opinion, OOG outlined applicable legal standards and identified necessary remedial measures. The public body has been made aware of its obligations under the Open Meetings Act, and OOG is actively monitoring its compliance. Because the concerns raised in your complaint have been resolved and are subject to ongoing oversight, no further investigation or enforcement action is warranted at this time. OOG will take the information you provided under advisement in connection with matter number OOG-2025-0023. However, your new complaint is dismissed as moot pursuant to 3 DCMR § 10403.1(f), and OOG therefore considers this matter closed.
