The Office of Open Government (OOG), pursuant to the authority set forth in § 503(a)(4) of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, effective March 31, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-350; D.C. Official Code § 2-593 *et seq.* (2017)), and 3 DCMR § 10400 *et seq.* (2017), has reviewed your complaint, assigned file number OOG_0008_9.23.17, in which you allege that the Office of Tax and Revenue (OTR) has failed to provide you with your 2015 District of Columbia income tax refund check and the results of its investigation concerning the refund.

The enforcement authority of the OOG extends only to violations committed by District of Columbia public bodies under the Open Meetings Act (D.C. Official Code § 2-571 et seq.) The OOG does not have jurisdiction over the alleged violations you raise. Therefore, your complaint is closed. However, you may be able to obtain copies of the documents relevant to your 2015 income tax refund through submission of a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of the Chief Financial Officer (CFO). FOIA requests may be submitted to the CFO electronically through the District's FOIA Portal, or by email, facsimile, regular mail or orally. You may access the District's FOIA Portal at https://foia-dc.gov. Should you choose to submit a FOIA request electronically, the email address and telephone number of the CFO FOIA office are laverne.lee@dc.gov and (202) 727-9528. The OOG is able to assist you with drafting the FOIA request to the CFO.
