LCCAR PURPOSE STATEMENT

The purpose of LCCAR, as stated in the Mayor's Order, is "to utilize the knowledge and influence of its members to advise and support the District's for a Cleaner Anacostia River Project, and to address ongoing pollution to the river from sources in multiple jurisdictions, throughout the Anacostia River's watershed."

LCCAR MEMBERSHIP AND ACTIVITIES

- 22 members, convenes quarterly
- Comprised of high-ranking officials and environmental leaders from federal, state, and local agencies and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and other stakeholders with decades of experience working on the Anacostia River
- Members receive project updates, discuss issues pertaining to project implementation, share relevant data, and exchange ideas and best practices
- Serves as a mechanism for cooperation between government officials, NGOs, and others and reduces transaction costs by bringing relevant stakeholders into one shared space
- New Term: October 1 , 2021 through September 30, 2024
