 - a. No need for a low income adjustment
 - b. Final rule requires that ability to pay and imputation of income be data driven
 - c. Low income and self-support reserve discussed
 - d. Imputation of income must be used to fill evidentiary gaps and a reasonable effort to gather evidence must be made
 - e. Court must make a finding a fact
 - f. Need for transparency for GL commission work
