- Chair Beckford inquired on how commissioners can assist.

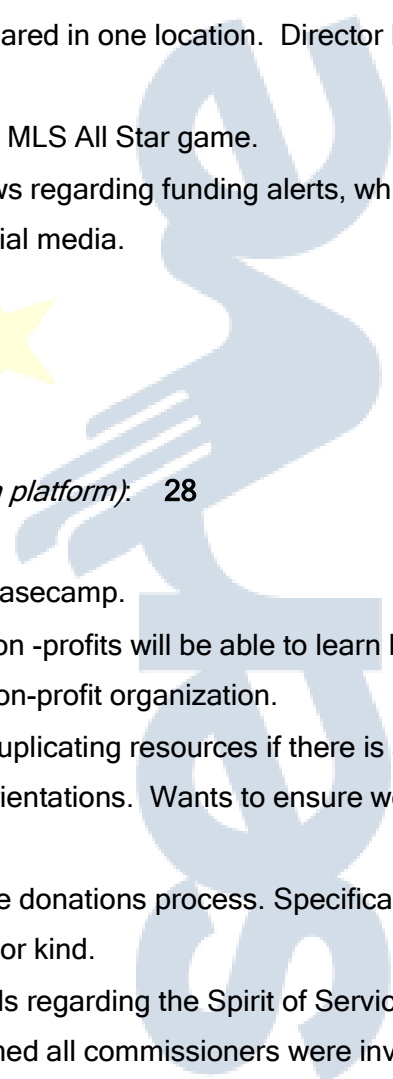
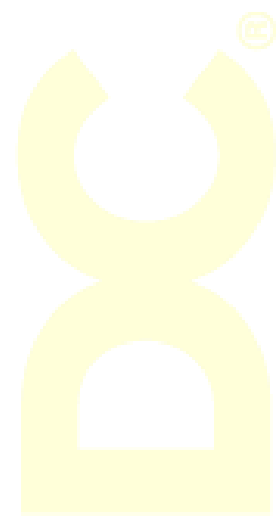
