The Commission discussed the bill entitled the "Common Interest Community Manager Licensing Amendment Act of 2017" with representatives (Legislative Director, Barry Weise, and Legislative Fellow, Kimie Matsuo) from Councilmember Anita Bonds' office during the meeting. The discussion focused on the historical background of the licensing bill with regard to problems involving condominium owners, low income residents, and management companies that offer little support to common interest associations and boards. Mr. Weise indicated that the bill is to provide support to the residents and to ensure that persons performing common interest managing services are educated, licensed and can perform the work related to common interest associations and residents. Mr. Weise stated that the estimated time for introduction of the bill is mid-July. He stated that the Commission could provide input on its concerns, and that he would inform Councilmember Bonds. The Commission members, legal counsel and staff informed the representatives that the Commission has been working on proposed legislation requiring a prelicensing course in property management to incorporate the major areas of property management, as well as to address concerns expressed by the public via complaints received by the Commission. The representatives and the Commission agreed that the Commission would make recommendations to Councilmember Bonds regarding the area of property management and its concerns relating to the proposed bill as soon as possible. On behalf of the Commission, Chairperson Ricks expressed appreciation to the representatives from Councilmember Bond's office for their participation with the Commission on discussion of the proposed bill.

Regarding the late filing period (grace period) that occurs after each licensing cycle, Mr. Cooks informed the Commission that there will not be a late filing period after the salespersons' cycle has ended because of a change in licensing vendors from Pearson Vue to PSI. He added that all expired salesperson licenses must be reinstated after August 31, 2017.

The legal counsel, Kia Winston, informed the Commission that emergency rulemaking must be done to accommodate this change. The draft language will be reviewed at the next scheduled meeting of the Commission for approval for publication.
