Chairperson Ricks stated that the meeting was a good one. The Councilmember requested that the position of the Commission be included in the proposed bill and sent to her office by close of business on July 3, 2017. Ms. Winston drafted and finalized the proposed legislation reflecting the Commission's position that was transferred to the Office of Policy and Legislative Affairs and provided to the councilmember by the deadline. The bill was introduced on July 11, 2017, and is known as the "Property Manager Licensing

Amendment Act of 2017." Chairperson Ricks commended the work of Ms. Winston with the expedited turn-around to the councilmember.

Agenda Item: New Business

Regarding the Real Estate Educators Annual Conference that was held in Miami, Florida, Mr. Cyrus stated that it was a good conference, where the emphasis on new technology and software in delivering real estate education courses by real estate educational providers was the highlight.

Regarding staff approval of real estate applications for licensure and education applications submitted by educational providers and waivers, the following motion was voted on:

Upon motion duly made by Commissioner Pietranton and properly seconded by Commissioner Gulstone, the Commission unanimously voted to authorize Mr. Lewis to approve real estate applications for licensure not requiring a technical review and the education unit to approve real estate education-related applications and endorsement applicants that don't require technical review during the recess period until the next meeting and when the Commission does not have a quorum.

The development of a prelicensing course outline for property management licensure inclusive of common interest community management;

To review and make recommendations regarding the broker and salesperson prelicensing education course curriculum;

The development of continuing education courses to include property and community management for property managers, real estate brokers, and salespersons; and The development of a course for all members of a community association board required by the "Communities Remedial Funding Act of 2017."

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The legislative team at DCRA and the Office of Policy and Legislative Affairs (OPLA) sent a series of questions to the Commission for responses regarding the proposed property management legislation.

Upon motion duly made by Commissioner Gulstone and properly seconded by Commissioner Pietranton, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the responses.

A letter was sent to all Commission members regarding the upcoming transition from Pearson Vue to PSI from the Occupational and Professional Licensing Division.

The Commission reviewed an e-mail invite from Kimie Matsuo regarding a possible meeting with the Community Associations Institute at Councilmember Bonds' office. Mr. Lewis stated that he would communicate possible dates at a later time.
