Discussion whether to recommend that the Director of the Department of Health increase the amount of medical marijuana a patient may receive within a thirty (30) day period from two (2) ounces to four (4) ounces. The Subcommittee will further discuss whether the recommendation should apply to all forms of medical marijuana or only certain forms.

After hearing comments from the public during the May 2016 Subcommittee Meeting, in an effort to make a clinically-based and informed recommendation to the Director, the Subcommittee needed to seek assistance for recommending physicians to obtain information that would assist it in determining how patients are responding to medical marijuana treatment, the medical efficacy and possible effects of recommending this potential change to the Medical Marijuana Program.
